HIKING - Hwy 93 North of Whitefish

Finger Lake - 1.5 mile hike to a small pristine lake with a rise in elevation of less than 100 ft... Travel 7 miles past Olney on Hwy 93 North... Turn left at the Upper Stillwater Lake Recreational Site. Follow the main road. Do not take any side roads and proceed over the RR tracks. After the tracks, take a sharp left up the hill at the Stillwater Lake sign. Follow the road to the campground/parking lot where there is a sign to Finger Lake Trail. Rough road.

Spencer Lake Trails Take Hwy 93 North from Whitefish towards Eureka...Just past Spencer Lake, at mile marker 132, turn left onto Twin Bridges Road...Just past the lake you will see a pull out, on the left hand side, with trails heading off up and into the forest behind the lake... Bring Water.

Hwy 93 South to Hwy 40 East of Whitefish

Cyclone Peak, from Hwy 40, head toward Columbia Falls... Turn left on Nucleus Ave. and continue north until the road ends...

Turn right onto the North Fork Road and travel N 32 miles...Turn left at the sign marked Hay Creek Turnoff (before Polebridge)...Follow the signs to Cyclone Lookout, about 3.5 miles... The trailhead is on the left...

Farm to Market State Lands – (Hiking/Biking) Take Hwy 93 N toward Eureka. At mile marker 132 there is a pond on the left and Twin Bridges Rd. Take a left onto Twin Bridges. Follow to Lodgepole Rd to Farm to Market Road. Follow Farm to Market to just before Kuhn Rd & the sign for Ray Kuhn Wildlife Reserve (on left). The parking area and trails on the RIGHT. If you see Farm to Market Pork Place, you have gone 1.5 miles too far.
